
## **NAICS Codes**

NAICS (North American Industrial Classification System) codes classify industries and can be used to search and filter results in York University's business databases.

To find the NAICS code for an industry sector, start at Statistics Canada's NAICS Lookup site.




Select the code next to the sector that best describes the economic activity you want to research.

Alternatively, type the **name of the economic activity** in the search bar and press Enter/Return.



Read through the **NAICS code break-down** to view the different levels of specificity. The shorter the code, the more high-level the industry category will be.




Use all six digits in the NAICS code when you want to target your research to a specific country or national industry. (The sixth digit represents both.)




Click the code that best matches your need from the **results list**.
